In a report published November 17, 2009, *BusinessWeek* named Tinley Park, Illinois as the highest ranked town in their 4th annual survey of the [*Best Places to Raise Your Kids*](#).



The *BusinessWeek* article noted that safety, along with school test scores, air quality, and affordability, were weighted especially high in this year's calculations. Job growth, diversity, and local amenities such as museums, parks, and theatres were also factored into the evaluation.

Two elementary school districts serve the residents of Tinley Park: Kirby School District 140 and Community Consolidated School District 146; with two high school districts providing secondary level education: Victor J. Andrew High School (Consolidated High School District 230) and Tinley Park High School (Bremen Community High School District 228).

Mayor Ed Zabrocki was quoted in a Village of Tinley Park news release as saying, "Of course, we've known for years that our village is a great place for families – a wonderful town in which to live, work, play and raise children – but it's exciting that our Village is recognized now by a national and highly respected magazine that specializes in understanding what makes a place highly livable and special."
